

CWDA Waiver and Policies

TUITION

All cash/check/credit tuition payments are due by the 5th of the month.. If payments are received late, a \$10 late fee is assessed.

EFT payments are scheduled to automatically be withdrawn on or near the 1st of the month.

Cash payments – CWDA is happy to accept cash payments, but the payment must be for the exact amount. We will be unable to make change.

Yearly tuition is calculated for the entire school year and then split into nine monthly installments for family budgeting/convenience purposes.

Monthly tuition is non-refundable. The office must be notified in writing no later than 10 days before a new month's tuition is due if a student wishes to withdraw from a class. If notice is not given, tuition for that upcoming month will be charged.

YEAR END PERFORMANCE

- Costume fees for the year end performance, due in January, range from \$70-\$90.
- Parents are responsible for purchasing new tights for the show as well as purchasing tickets for the performance. Participation in the year end show is optional for all students.

CLASS ATTIRE

- All students are expected to purchase the appropriate dancewear and shoes required for their class(es).

SUPERVISION

- A parent or guardian must be present in the lobby to supervise their child under the age of 8 until their class officially starts.

SNOW DATES

- In case of class cancellation due to snow or other inclement weather, students may make up that class in an appropriate level either above or below their current level. There are no refunds for snow days.

DRESSING ROOMS

- Students are not allowed to eat or drink (except water) in the dressing rooms. All food and beverages must be consumed in the waiting room.
- The lockers in the dressing room are for students 8 years or older who attend classes on two separate days during the week.
- Students must be high school age or older to stay in the dressing room until class begins. All younger students must wait for class in the lobby.

LOBBY BEHAVIOR Students are not allowed to:

- Stand, jump, kneel or lay down on any of the furniture in the lobby.
- No "roughhouse behavior" (running, leaping, screaming, physical game playing and throwing of any objects) is allowed for the safety of all.
